RECORD OF EVENTS

6 June 1944: Forward Echelon, Welford Park Airfield, Berkshire, England left field at 2040 in Horsa Gliders on combat mission. Gliders made crash landings around Ste Mere Eglise, France with great damage and no casualties among medical personnel. 1 Off & 1 EM in Glider forced down near take Off field. Casualties of minor bruises were treated.

7 June 1944: Moved in position at 1030 hrs. approx 1 mile from St Mere Eglise, France. Many casualties were treated and wounded evacuated. Casualties very heavy. 1 Off & 1 EM landed in glider at LZ and were shelled by enemy.

8 June 1944: Casualties were treated and evacuated throughout the day.

9 June 1944: 2 EM of Seaborne element joined detachment. Previous casualties treated and tags placed of personnel Killed in Action.

10 June 1944: Casualties treated and evacuated others treated for minor injuries. Area Dived bombed & strafed by enemy planes. Moral excellent.
